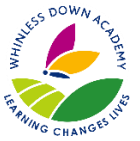

How many pasta shells did Ben need?</li> <li>2) Complete the attached ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION activity.</li> </ol>	<p style="text-align: center;">What is a habitat? (Use the attached power point to help.)</p> <p>Choose an ocean, from one of the world's oceans that surround Africa, and complete the OCEAN HABITAT FACT FILE attached. Find out all about the plants and animals that live in your ocean.</p>

<p>Expanded noun phrases use more than one adjective (describing word) to describe the noun (person, animal, place or object).</p> <p style="text-align: center;">For example: The cat becomes... The big black cat or the fluffy ginger cat.</p> <p>Try adding a size or other describing word, plus a colour, to make expanded noun phrases to describe the pictures on the NOUN PHRASES activity.</p>	<p>Can you find information about a country in the continent of Africa? What is the weather like there? What is the scenery like? What things are there to see or do? Use the information to create a poster for a holiday company, advertising why people should visit this country.</p> <p>If you are stuck, see the EXAMPLE HOLIDAY LEAFLET attached for ideas.</p>	<p>In the garden or indoor space, use recycling card or household objects (broom, mop, hula hoop, slide, paddling pool etc.) to arrange the world's continents in roughly the correct places.</p> <p>Label the continents then ask an adult to instruct you to move from one continent to the next, using given moves. EG. Start in Africa, swim to Europe, hop on your left foot to Asia etc.</p> <p>Now see if you can remember how to get back to Africa, visiting each continent in reverse order, using the correct movement.</p>
