## English

**Star Author:** There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom by Louis Sachar

**Fiction:** Reading and writing narratives in the style of the author.

**Non- Fiction:** Writing biographies.

## Topic: Fit for Life

**Science:** Identifying the main parts of the human circulatory system; understanding the function of each.

**History:** Researching the work of William Harvey and the importance of his work on the circulation of blood.
