## Online Safety: TikTok

TikTok is a social media app that lets you watch, create, and share videos, but the app features mature content that is not appropriate for children. TikTok requires that users be at least 13 years old to use the app and that anyone under the age of 18 must have approval of a parent or guardian. TikTok's main feature 'For You' Page is a random stream of videos, so you do not have control over the type of videos presented on the home screen, making it inappropriate for children under 13 to view.
