Introducing Dover Pantry









Dover Pantry is a new community food store, opening 20th January 2021

Located on the High Street, Unit 16, in the Charlton Centre

Opening initially on Wednesdays from 10am-2pm

Providing local families, who are struggling financially, with access to affordable and healthy fresh food and store cupboard staples

For a weekly membership fee of £5, members can shop once a week and can save £650 on their food bills*

A range of volunteer roles are available, providing valuable work experience and opportunities to meet people in the local area.

Background

What is a Pantry?



- Dover Pantry is a franchise of Your Local Pantry (<u>www.yourlocalpantry.co.uk</u>)
- It will provide members in the Dover area with access to affordable food for a weekly membership fee of £5
- The membership fee is used to keep the store running and stocked with essentials
- Stock is provided by the national charity FareShare and using surplus stock from local food retailers
- A selection of healthy, good quality foods are available, all within their use by dates
- The store is run by the community for the community. With the support of the Store Manager, volunteers keep the shelves stocked and the Pantry running.

How does it work?



- Members of the Pantry are invited to shop once a week, for a weekly membership fee of £5.
- When arriving at the store, members are greeted by our Store Manager, and volunteers and checked in before they shop, using their membership ID card.
- Members are then able to choose up to 15 items each week from a selection of chilled, frozen, fresh and store cupboard items.
- Stock will change week to week, depending on what FareShare and local supermarkets provide, but there should always be a good selection of staples available.
- Members can pay their subscription each week before they shop.

What area will Dover Pantry serve?



Membership is available to people living in the following locations:

- Buckland Parish Ward
- Maxton & Elms Vale Parish Ward
- Rokesley Parish Ward
- St. Radigund's Parish Ward
- Tower Hamlets Parish Ward
- Town & Castle Parish Ward

Membership criteria...

To be eligible to join the Pantry, members will need to answer "yes" to at least one of the following questions as part of the application process:

- Do you ever struggle to pay rent?
- Do you ever struggle to pay energy bills?
- Do you ever struggle to pay for other essentials?
- Have you had to cut back on the amount you spend on shopping in the last three months?
- Do you ever run out of money toward the end of the week?

How to sign-up as a member...

- 1. Visit https://www.yourlocalpantry.co.uk/doverpantry/ and complete the online membership application form.

 Or call 07898 045384 to complete an application over the phone (opening hours: 10am to 12pm Mon Fri)
- 2. Applications will be reviewed and all individuals contacted to advise if they are approved as a member (subject to step 4), have been put on a waiting list, or have been declined membership due to having not met the criteria.
- 3. All approved members are required to visit the Pantry to show proof of address, and photo ID and to pay their first weekly subscription of £5.
- 4. Approved members will be allocated a membership number and will be provided with a **membership card** and pack.
- 5. Members on the waiting list will be offered places as soon as capacity is sufficient to take on more members, or membership spaces become free.

Volunteer opportunities...

- The Pantry will be run by the Store Manager, with the support of volunteers from the local community
- Volunteering provides valuable work experience and the opportunity to meet new people in the local area
- Roles include:
 - Pantry Assistants to welcome customers and assist with their shopping
 - Stock Assistants to manage stock deliveries, and assist with heavy lifting and manual handling
 - Supermarket Surplus Food Collectors to pick up goods and deliver to the Pantry.
