










TERM 5 - WHERE DOES IT COME FROM? HOME LEARNING

Can you find any of the digraphs and trigraphs that we have learnt?</p> 	<p>Have a look in the kitchen for 6 different objects. Make sure you have an adult to help you. Which one is the heaviest? Which one is the lightest? Can you put them in order from lightest to heaviest?</p> 
<p>Look at some of the food in your cupboards and fridge. Where in the world do they come from? Write a list in your homework book.</p> 	<p>The Beanstalk in Jack and The Beanstalk grew VERY tall. Can you find something in your house that is taller than you and something that is shorter than you? Draw and label them in your book.</p> 	<p>We have been learning about numbers 9 and number 10. Can you count 9 and 10 objects in your house and write the numbers in your homework book.</p> 
<p>Research some jewel from around the world. Can you make sure your own unique piece of jewellery?</p> 	<p>Draw a picture of a plant or flower. Can you label the different parts e.g. stem, leaf etc.</p> 	<p>We have been growing plants this term. Try and grow some at home! Remember to be Respectful Rabbits and look after them as they grow! Can you email some photos when they have grown?</p> 

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
