Can you recite the numbers to your family? You could record them in your book as an extra challenge.</p> 
<p>We can travel in many different ways to explore new places. Can you draw 5 different types of transport that you might use to travel? Challenge: can you add some descriptive labels such as red bus or big wheels?</p> 	<p>Can you choose a page from a magazine and see how many digraphs you find on it? Can you underline them? Which is the heaviest? Which is the lightest? Challenge: Can you order the fruits from the heaviest to the lightest?</p> 
<p>Lots of safari animals live in Africa. Each animal has their own special patterned skin. Can you design your own safari animal? What will the pattern on its skin look like? Will it be stripy like a tiger or spotty like a cheetah?</p> 	<p>We have started to learn about capital letters. Can you write the letters of the alphabet in order? Can you write the capital letters too?</p> 	<p>We are learning about different ways to travel. One way to travel is on a boat. Can you make a boat using things around your house? For example, plastic containers or a bottle. Challenge: check to see if your boat will float or sink.</p>
