<b>Understanding the World</b>	Lesson 3 We are really hoping that we are going to have some chicks hatch from our eggs. We should have a mixture of girl and boy chicks. With an adult to help you, can you use the internet and find out what colour boy chicks are and what colour girl chicks are. Can you draw some and maybe use your phonics to write some possible names for them?
<b>Maths</b>	Lesson 4 Can you find 6 objects in your house that are the same e.g. 6 pencils, 6 lego bricks etc. Can you use these to help you find as many number bond to 6 as possible. e.g. $1 + 5 = 6$ , $2 + 4 = 6$ etc. Can you have a go at writing them down? How many can you find?

- read your reading book, making sure you are decoding any unfamiliar words and reading with expression (prosody).
