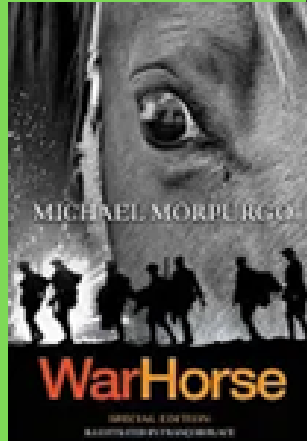


## English

## Maths

Number Maths: The Four Operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) calculating using mental and formal methods.

Topic Maths: Properties of 2D shapes with a focus on angles.

We will apply our learning to problem solving and reasoning challenges.
