

Remember to check your spellings and punctuation.</p> <p><i>Try to include: expanded noun phrases, adverbs, fronted adverbials, conjunctions and powerful vocabulary.</i></p> <p><i>Don't forget your punctuation!</i></p> <p><b>3 points</b></p>	<p><b>COMPULSORY TASK</b></p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Find out the volume of water in each of the world's 5 oceans. Atlantic, Pacific, Southern, Indian and Arctic Oceans</p> <p>Put the oceans in order based on their volume. Place in descending order - biggest to smallest.</p> <p><b>2 points</b></p>	<p><b>COMPULSORY TASK</b></p> <p>Choose from a: whale, penguin, turtle, and dolphin.</p> <p>Create a poster about them, and discuss the habitat in which they live, and what dangers threaten their habitats.</p> <p><b>3 points</b></p>
<p><b>COMPULSORY TASK</b></p> <p>Create a poem or song to explain why children need to protect the oceans and stop plastic pollution.</p>  <p><b>2 points</b></p>	<p>Complete the equivalent fractions sheet, remembering our learning from last term.</p> <p><u>Fraction</u></p> <p><math>\frac{4}{7}</math> numerator denominator</p> <p><b>2 points</b></p>	<p><b>2 points</b></p> <p><b>Investigate how we can reduce the amount of plastic we use.</b></p> <p>Write a pledge to yourself, giving three ways you will try to use less plastic (this can be for your whole family too!).</p>
