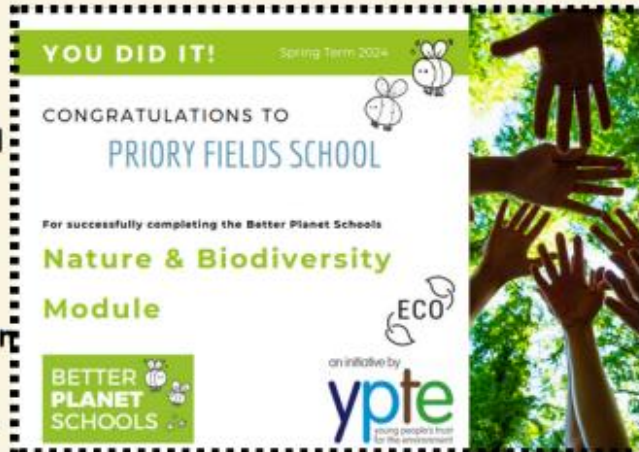




Eco Defenders
