









What are they called? What 2D shapes can you spot on them? How many edges or sides do they have? How many corners?</p>  <p>2</p>	<p>Make a seaside collage using different materials. What human, man-made features can you see (e.g. promenade, ice cream huts?) What makes the beach a good place for people to visit?
