Year 4 have had the most amazing time visiting the Powell Cotton Museum at Quex Park. The museum features over 300 embalmed animals and over 150 species, all set in realistic dioramas of their natural habitat.

Although the children discussed the ethics of not killing animals for display, they learnt about the reasons why this was done during the Victorian era.

They not only looked at the displays but were able to touch skins and skulls as well as engage in printing workshops.
