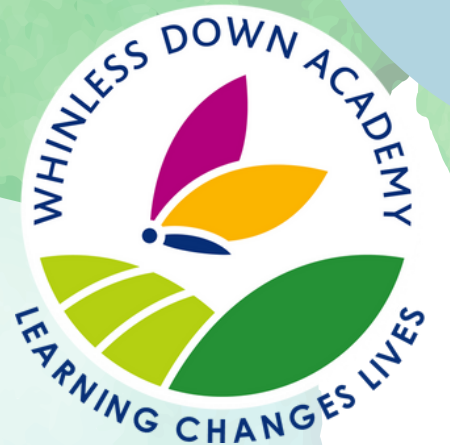
Thank you for supporting my family when we really needed it
