



## Curriculum Overview-

Why oh, why did the Anglo Saxons leave their home countries? What did England look like when they arrived? Who was here before them and who came next? As Historians we will explore a range of sources to discover the legacy that the Anglo Saxons left behind. From the Romans leaving to the arrival of Christianity to the Battle of Hastings in 1066, we will learn how when one great civilisation ends, another civilisation will replace it and bring with them changes to custom, culture and society. As Diligent designers we will use fabric to design, create and evaluate Anglo Saxon coin purses mastering the running stitch, decorating with cross-stitch and make a working drawstring.

## English

During our English and writing lessons, we will be exploring 'How to be an Anglo-Saxon in 13 easy steps', 'The Tale of King Arthur' and 'The Sword in the Stone'. We will be learning how to use inverted commas for direct speech so that we can use this whilst writing our own version of 'The Sword in the Stone'.

## Maths

We will be continuing to follow the White Rose scheme of learning. We will continue to embed our understanding of addition and subtraction and understand that we can use the inverse to check our answer. We will also be exploring multiplication and division. Please practise your 2, 5 and 20 times tables at home.

## Reading -

We will be focusing on developing our inference skills; exploring the thoughts and feelings of different character. We will also look at creating predictions with simple justifications
