









# Year 1 Term 2 'The Seasonal Journey': Home Learning - Due 16<sup>th</sup> December 2024

<p><b>Rhyming -</b> Write your own poem about the seasons. Try to use some rhyming words. <b>3 points</b></p> 	<p><b>Addition -</b> Can you practice your adding skills? Can your grown-ups give you some problems to solve up to ten? Remember you can use objects to help you. <b>3 points</b></p> 	<p><b>Seasons -</b> Create a seasons picture using different materials. Can you write underneath the name of the season and add adjectives to describe your season? <b>3 points</b></p> 
<p><b>Spelling -</b> Where can you find the days of the week? Do you know their order? Learn a song, find them in real life or practice with your adults. <b>3 points</b></p> 	<p><b>Subtraction -</b> Can you practice your subtraction number sentences? Remember to use the minus and equals symbols. Can you subtract numbers from ten? <b>3 points</b></p> 	<p><b>Weather -</b> Can you keep a log of the weekly weather? You could draw pictures or take photos or make a weather report. <b>3 points</b></p> 
<p><b>Basic Skills Bonus -</b> Practice reading your digraphs and trigraphs, can you find some in your reading book? <b>2 points</b></p> 	<p><b>Shape -</b> Go on a shape hunt. What shapes can you find? You could take photos or draw them. <b>2 points</b></p> 	<p><b>Weather -</b> Make something to measure the weather. It could be a wind chime, rain gauge or a sun catcher. <b>2 points</b></p>
