## Year 6 - E-waste Project!




## E-SAFETY – Talking to Your Child About AI

Children may use AI tools for homework, games or curiosity, but it's important they understand how to use them safely. Remind your child that AI is not always accurate and can sometimes give confusing or misleading answers. Encourage them to ask you or a teacher if they're unsure. Just like with the internet, children should never share personal details (such as their name, address, school or photos) with an AI system. Use it together at home so you can guide them, show interest, and model safe use. Open conversations build confidence and keep children safe online.
