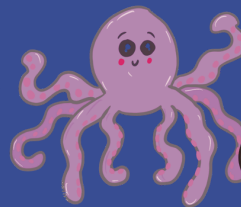

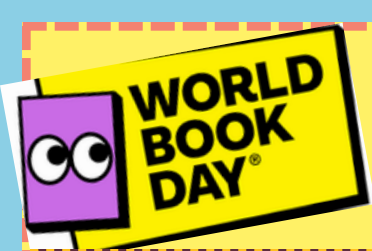
## STUART HERITAGE IS BACK!
