



Curriculum Overview-

Whilst exploring the lives of the pre-historic era, we will become aware as historians of what changed over time between the Stone Age and Iron Age, including; their homes, clothing and food. We will investigate how this pre-historic era impacted our life today.

As geographers, we will consider the areas of their settlement as well as designing homes as if Dover was the area of settlement.

Using the style of cave paintings, we will consider, 'How does Art speak to people?', 'Can we use Art to tell a story?'

English

This term we will be reading the text 'The Stone Age boy'. Using this text, we will write a diary, plan and write our own adventure story using historical language and write an information text to share our knowledge of our topic.

We will continue to learn about writing in paragraphs and learn how to uplevel our vocabulary.

Maths

This term will be focusing our learning on fractions, money and time.

In fractions, we will learn how to add and subtract fractions and how to find fractions of a set of objects.

In money, we will learn how to convert pounds into pence, add and subtract money and learn how to find change.

As we start to learn about time we will learn about roman numerals to 12 and then learn how to tell the time to the nearest minute.

Reading -

This term in reading we will be focusing on the following skills; summarise, vocabulary and retrieval.

Key Vocabulary -

Paleolithic - The name given to the period of time relating to the earliest part of the Stone Age.

Mesolithic - The middle period of the Stone Age.

Neolithic - The newest and last period of the Stone Age.

Archaeologist - A person who studies history and pre-history.

Chronology - A study of time in the order events occurred.

We will learn spelling rules with word endings sounding like -sure, -ture and -sion. We will also be learning how to use the possessive apostrophe for singular nouns.
