



Curriculum Overview-

This term we will continue our learning about World War Two. Our focus for learning will be: The Home Front. We will evaluate the impact of nationally significant events during World War 2, including: the impact of propaganda; rationing and VE Day, and further explore how this was experienced in our locality. Our key skills will be using and interpreting primary resources to discuss the past.

English -

To begin our term, we will be writing our own wartime recipes, and cross-curricular writing with newspaper reports celebrating VE day. Our key text will be Skellig by David Almond, from this we will be writing: descriptive narratives, diary entries and narratives from alternative viewpoints. Our key reading skills this term are: predict and retrieval.

Additionally, we will be revising key GPS terms and reading skills for the SATS tests.

Maths -

This term our focus will be learning about algebra, including solving equations. Additionally, we will be revising key areas of our Maths curriculum, for example: the four operations, fractions, decimals and percentages in order to prepare for our upcoming SATS.

Times tables: It is still important to practice rapid recall of times tables, target tables have been set on TTRS.
