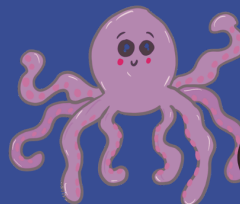
1<sup>st</sup> – Thomas – 99.2%

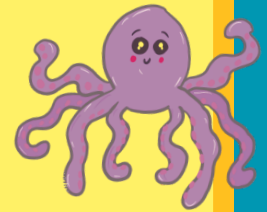

Primary-aged children are increasingly targeted by sophisticated online scams, particularly through gaming platforms and video-sharing apps. These scams are designed to look like exciting rewards but often aim to steal personal information or password details.

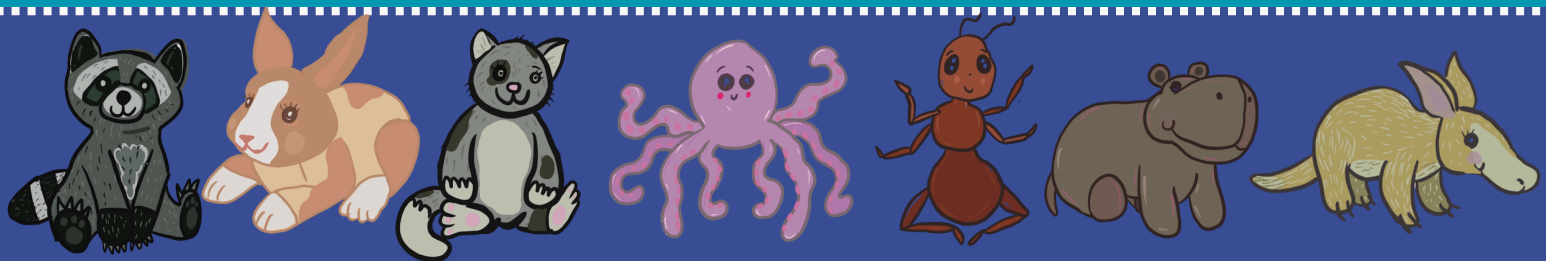
## Common Scams to Watch Out For:

- **Free In-Game Currency:** Fake pop-ups or videos promising free Robux, V-Bucks, or Minecoins in exchange for clicking a link or filling out a survey.
- **Fake Giveaways:** Scammers posing as popular YouTubers or influencers claiming the child has won a smartphone, iPad, or rare gaming skin.
- **Malicious Downloads:** Links offering "free mods," cheats, or early access to popular games that actually download harmful viruses onto your home devices.

## What You Can Do at Home:

- **Teach Critical Thinking:** Remind your child the golden rule of the internet: "If it looks too good to be true, it probably is."
- **Enforce Password Privacy:** Ensure your child knows never to type their login details or personal information into any website without checking with you first.

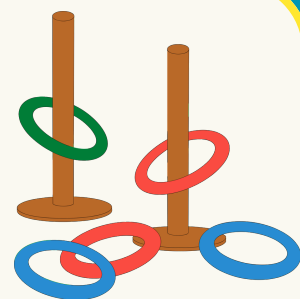
