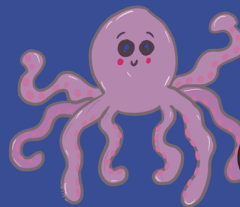

Kindness Online Matters



At Priory Fields, our values don't stop when we go online:

Our Respectful Rabbit reminds us to think carefully about the words we use online. Comments, messages and posts can have a lasting impact on others, even if they are not said face-to-face.

Our Responsible Raccoon teaches us to make good choices online and to consider the consequences of our actions before we click, post or send.

Children should remember:

- **Think before you type.**
- **Be kind and respectful in online games, messages and comments.**
- **Never post something online that you wouldn't be happy to say in person.**

If something online upsets you or makes you feel uncomfortable, tell a trusted adult.

A useful family conversation this week could be:

"How would you feel if someone sent that message to you?"

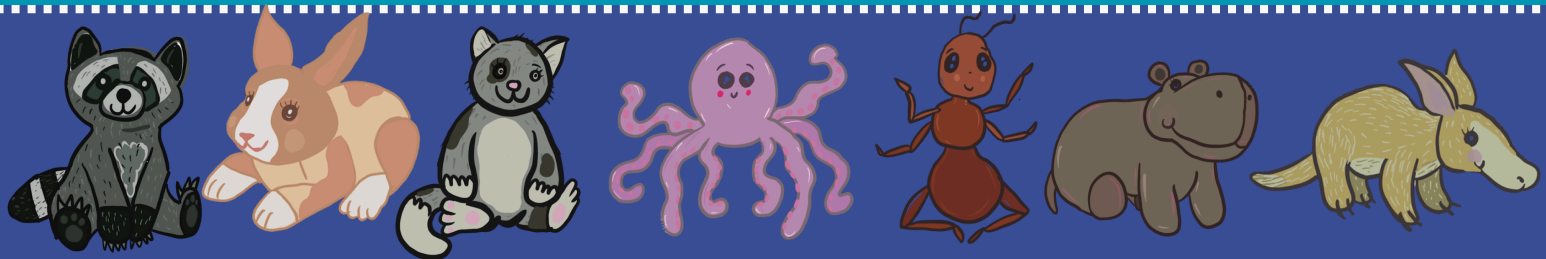
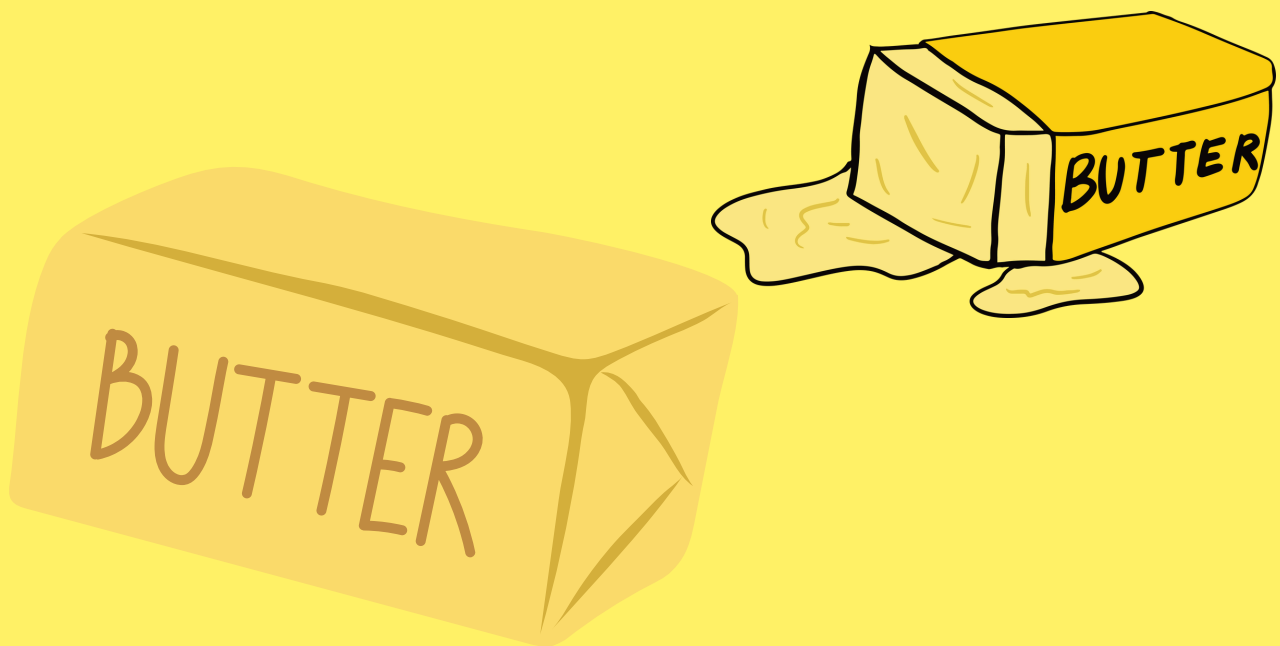
Helping children develop empathy online is one of the most effective ways to keep them safe and promote positive digital behaviour.
