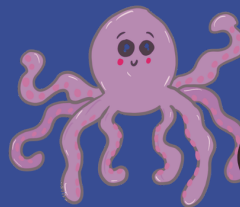
1st – Thomas – 98.3%

We have recently met with ABC Library, who are excited to support us in developing a fantastic new library space for our children. We are so close to making this wonderful opportunity a reality.

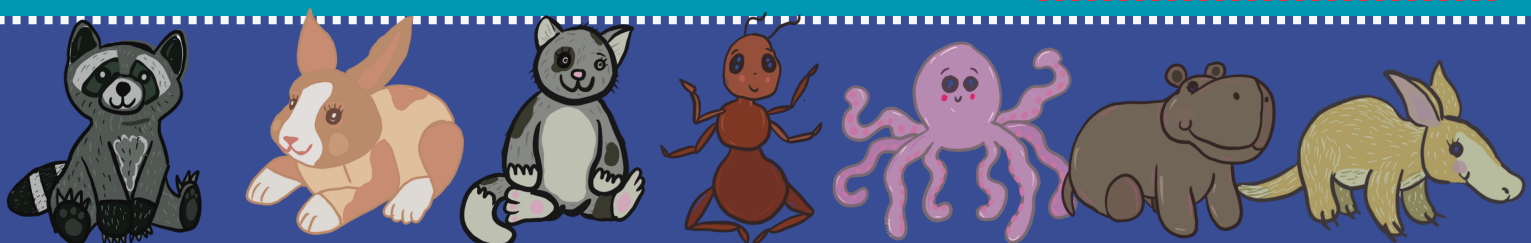
