Important Information For All Parents

If you haven't already attempted to download the school gateway app, you need to do so now. From next term, you will not be able to pay for anything by cash in the school office. We are asking all parents to download the app now so that any registration issues can be resolved before the end of term.

If you have the app and are experiencing problems with registering or paying, please come in to the school office.

Booking Clubs

From next term, you will need to book your child's place on clubs via the app. Clubs will not be able to be booked without payment. This means that if you intend to book a club for the whole term, you will need to pay for the term in advance via the app. You will not be able to book a club place at the school office as before.
